

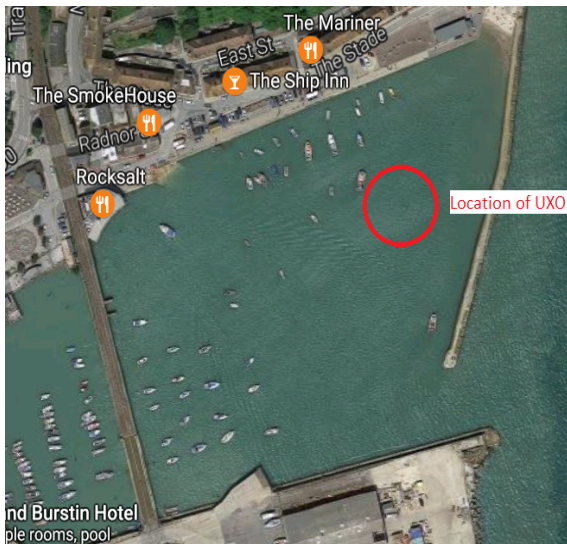

## NOTICE TO MARINERS No 6 of 2017

### UNEXPLODED ORDNANCE IN FOLKESTONE OUTER HARBOUR

During dredging works an item of unexploded ordnance, suspected to be WW2 bomb, has been discovered in the Outer Harbour.

The position of the bomb is:- 51° 4' 49"N 1° 11' 22.5"E (see picture below)



On the advice of RN Bomb Disposal an exclusion area of 100m centred on the UXB has been imposed. RN Bomb Disposal will be in attendance at 1300BST 30<sup>th</sup> March 2017.

All port users should be aware and must observe this exclusion area. This notice to mariners will be cancelled when the item is removed.
